We are your partner in accompanying your children to grow, to connect them with their family, nature, technology, beliefs, arts, and the community surrounding them.

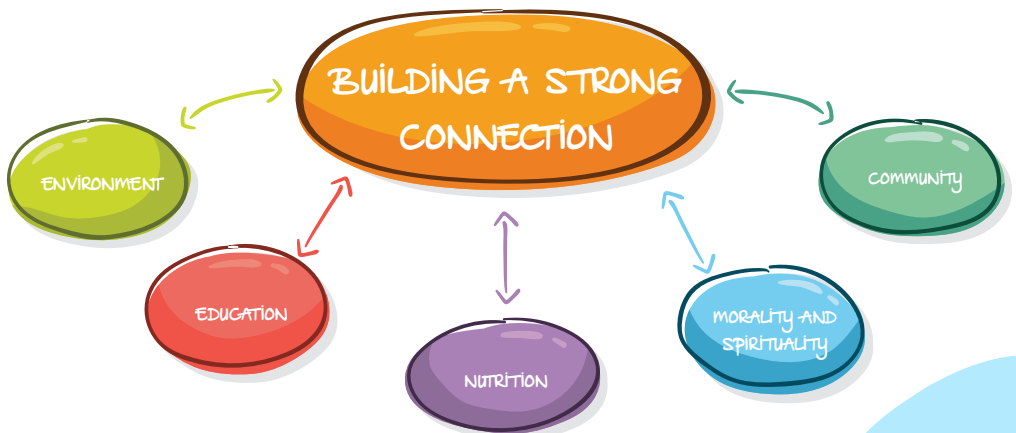
Like any good tree that grows, we must set our roots strong and deep to the ground.

These Five Roots of Growth are the foundation to

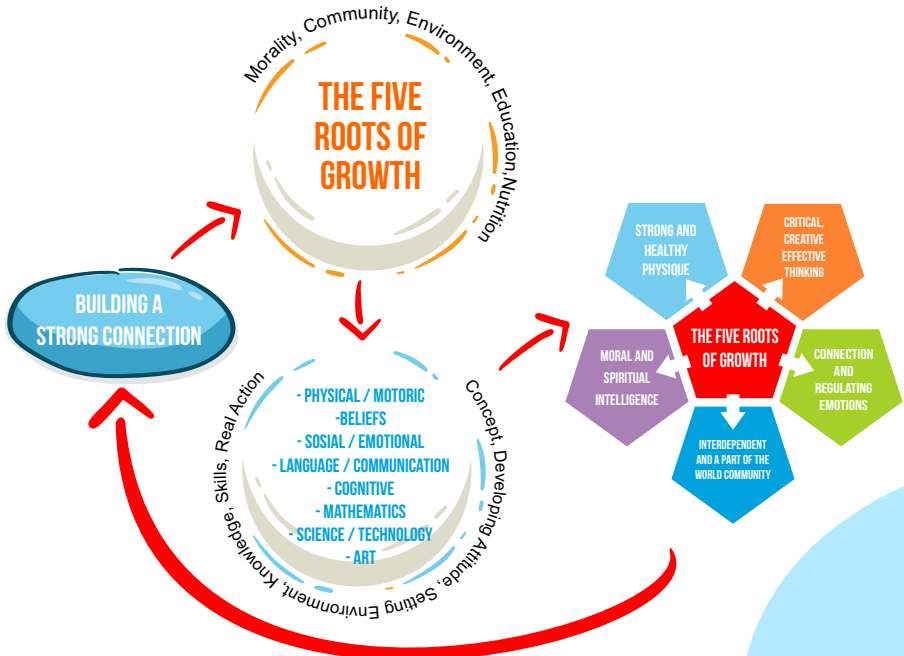
THE 5 ROOTS OF GROWTH



Our Curriculum

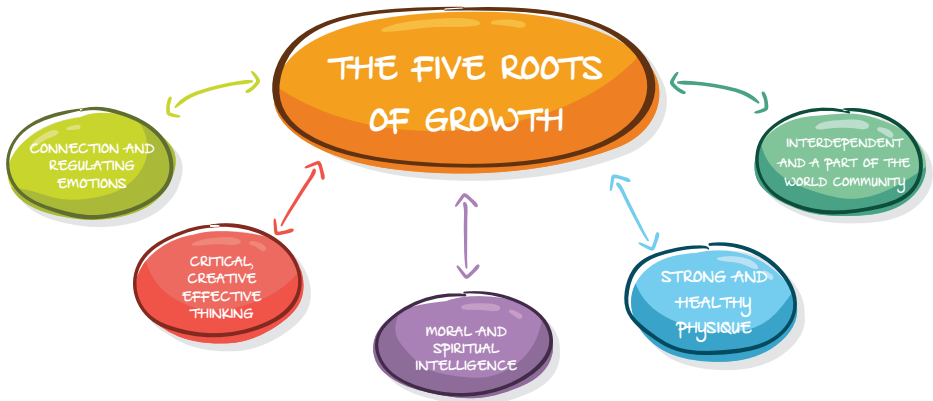

Therefore, the framework we created will be used and referred to as the core content in our teaching and learning activities.



The Five Sprouts Of Growth

How Do We Teach The Five Roots Of Growth?

There are six main points that outline what a student will do and learn based on the Roots Learning Center's philosophy and curriculum:



a. Comprehensive concepts

 - Motoric skills

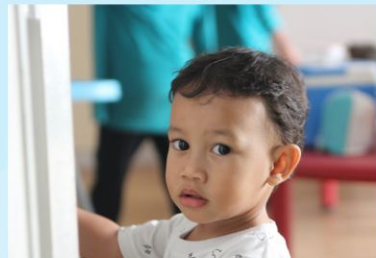
e. Developing attitude

Building a Positive Attitude

We believe that building connection and regulating emotions can establish a positive attitude in every child, and that is why we apply the 'restorative practice'.

'Restorative practice' is a series of ways that can be used to address conflict and misbehavior in school situations from the informal through to formal.

Our philosophy distinctly states that all the teaching-learning activities are done in a safe environment that is filled with mutual respect.

The policies at the Roots Learning Center have also embraced the restorative practice that specifically avoid any highrisk behaviors, such as bullying.

These policies focus on how to fix the relation between one another and undoubtedly avoid blaming and forcing punishment. We believe in connection before correction.

Information and Communication Technology (ICT)

In today's world we cannot live without technology and ought to be a part of it as long as its purpose and end goals are in accordance to the principles of education.

Therefore, we commit to always integrate technology into our curriculum early on as well as providing an environment where a new technology can be utilized to develop students' learning skills.

By taking advantage of technology in our education system, we aim to improve the quality of our teaching-learning environment for every member of our community at school and at the childcare by adjusting it to the early childhood's needs.

Literature

Here at the Roots Learning Center, we provide an environment rich of literature and language activities as a part of our communication skills.
